The Romsey Agricultural and Horse Show Society is a registered charity that exists to: "promote agriculture, forestry, horticulture, allied industries, rural crafts, the breeding of live-stock including horses, and to encourage skill and industry in such enterprises".

We support the local community through education and charitable donations. The Society has done this in Romsey and surrounding areas since 1842, initially in the town's Market Place and, since 1919, on the Broadlands Estate.

The show is held on the 2nd Saturday in September every year in the beautiful and historic Broadlands parkland setting which is still close enough for local residents to walk. Visitors include those of all ages and backgrounds. We regularly have:

24,000 visitors

500+ trade stands

700+ horse competitors

300+ other livestock competitors

There is a wide variety of livestock including cattle, sheep, horses, fur-and-feather along with displays of pigs, buffalo and otters.

Our large Food Zone area is where the food-lover can indulge their desires with plenty of choice of locally sourced and produced artisan food and drink. There is a demonstration kitchen hosting local chefs and food businesses, a have-a-go Kids Kitchen and a bakery demonstration along with a large picnic area where visitors can enjoy their purchases and be entertained with live music.

The Countryside Information Area and Ring play host to a variety of businesses and organisations that 'make the countryside tick', along with those working in wood, weaving, pony club, gun-dog displays, ferret racing, fishing and family dog show.

Main Ring attractions always include parade of machinery, heavy-horse display, Grand Parade of cattle and sheep, marching bands and show jumping. Each year we add new spectacles to capture the visitor's imagination. Past entertainment has included the Devil's Horsemen, Jason Smyth's "Adrenaline Tour" and WW1 Aerial Display, and we are always looking for something new and exciting. Other entertainment around the showground includes lots of activities for all ages with climbing walls, have-a-go crafts and inflatable play areas.

There are also plenty of opportunities to indulge in some 'retail therapy' with lots of choice for pockets and purses of all sizes. Stalls can be found in our Rural Industries marquee, specialising in home/hand-made craft items, Shopping, Horticulture/gardening marquees or in the rows of outside trade stands, whether you want a pencil or a house, a toy car or full-size tractor, a herb-filled pillow or a new garden, a Christmas present or a conservatory.

Partnership opportunities exist with the Society for the Show and throughout the year, via financial donations and/or 'gifts in kind'. Such partnerships enable the Society to fulfil its charitable obligations whilst ensuring that partners benefit from associated publicity and the knowledge that they are helping support the local community.

Local projects that the Society have supported include:

Hampshire Countryside Education Project - enabling local school children to undertake an annual project related to the countryside and/or agriculture. Links have been made with 10+ local schools and been undertaken by over 300 pupils ranging from 4 to 14 years old.

Romsey War Horse Memorial Project - to commemorate the WW1 Remount Camp in Romsey with the beautiful bronze statue in the Romsey War Memorial Park.

Various *local charities* through donations and by giving young people the opportunity of learning new skills by assisting at the show in stewarding positions.

We use the term 'partnership opportunities' for all support, whether through financial sponsorship or in-kind, to ensure that you are recognized, not just at the Show but throughout local communities.
