

RULES

1. Classes are open to all and are not restricted to members of NAFAS.
2. All classes will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015.
3. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.
4. Only one exhibit may be entered in any class by the same exhibitor.
5. The number of prizes to be awarded in each class shall be at the discretion of the judge.
6. All containers must be supplied by the exhibitor.
7. The Show Council will not be held responsible, at any time, for the loss of or damage to any property belonging to an exhibitor.
8. Staging to take place between 9.30am and 8.00pm on Friday 8th September 2017. The Floral Arrangement Marquee will be open to the public from 10.00am on Saturday 9th September 2017.
9. Only Officials and Judges will be allowed in the Floral Arrangement Marquee until judging is completed.
10. The Show Council reserves the right to refuse entry.
11. No exhibit is to be removed before 6.00pm.
12. The Judge's decision is final.
13. A free admission ticket will be given to any competitor with two or more entries in Classes 2-7. Three free admission tickets will be given for each Club entry in Class 1. Admission tickets will be handed to competitors on Staging Day.
14. Perpetual Challenge Trophies are held for one year and must be returned clean and undamaged to the Secretary, Romsey Show Office, 4 The Old Carhouses, Broadlands, Romsey, by 1st August 2018.
15. Entries will only be received on the attached form.

A Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the first prize winner in Class 1.

A Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the best exhibit in Classes 2-7.

“DANCE, DANCE, DANCE”

NATURAL PLANT MATERIAL TO PREDOMINATE

Class 1 (Club Class) “Strictly Come Dancing”. An Exhibit. Open to any Club, Group or Society. May be staged by not more than 3 members. Staged on grass. Space allowed 183cm wide x 183cm deep. Height optional. Base, if required to be provided by competitor. To be viewed all round but judged from the front.

Class 2. “Ceilidh”. An Exhibit. To be staged by 1 or 2 people. To be staged on a circular wooden base, 76cm in diameter, painted black and raised 10cm from the ground. Height optional. To be viewed and judged all round.

Class 3. “Twist and Shout”. An Exhibit. To be staged in a black niche. Space allowed 61cm wide (splaying to 76cm at front) x 66cm deep x 91cm high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 4. “Disco Queen”. An Exhibit. To be staged in a black niche. Space allowed 61cm wide (splaying to 76cm at front) x 66cm deep x 91cm high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 5. (Novice Class). “Tea Dance”. An Exhibit. Open to competitors who have never won 1st prize at Romsey Show. To be staged in a light beige niche. Space allowed 61cm wide (splaying to 76cm at front) x 66cm deep x 91cm high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 6. (Craft Class). “Put on Your Dancing Shoes”. A decorated shoe. Space allowed 40cm wide x 25cm deep. Height optional. May be brought ready assembled. To be viewed all round and judged from the front.

Class 7. (A petite exhibit). “Give Us a Twirl”. Space allowed 17cm wide x 17cm deep x 25cm high. To be staged on light beige open staging 1 metre from the ground. May be brought ready assembled. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Classes 3, 4 and 6 will be staged on tabling standing 73cm from the ground and covered in black fabric.

Class 5 will be staged on tabling standing 73cm from the ground and covered in light beige fabric.

All measures are approximate.

ENTRY FEES: Class 1 £2 per entry. Classes 2-7 £1 per entry.
