2. All classes will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015
3. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.
4. Only one exhibit may be entered in any class by the same exhibitor.
5. All containers must be supplied by the exhibitor.
6. The Show Council will not be held responsible, at any time, for loss or damage to any property belonging to the exhibitor.
7. Staging will take place between 9.30am and 8pm on Friday 13^h September 2019. Please bring your own hot drinks.
8. Only Officials and Judges will be allowed in the Floral Arrangement Marquee until judging is completed.
9. The Show Council reserves the right to refuse entry.
10. No exhibit is to be removed before 6.00pm on Show Day.
11. The Judge's decision is final.
12. A free admission ticket will be given to any competitor with two or more entries in classes 2-7. Three free admission tickets will be given to each Club entry in Class 1. Admission tickets will be handed to competitors on Staging Day.
13. Perpetual Challenge Trophies are held for one year and must be returned clean and undamaged to the Secretary, Romsey Show Office, 4 The Old Carhouses, Broadlands, Romsey by 1st August 2020.
14. Entries will only be received on the attached form.

NATURAL PLANT MATERIAL TO PREDOMINATE

Class 1: Where in the World Am I? An exhibit. Open to any club, group or society. To be staged by not more than 3 competitors. Staged on grass. Space allowed 150cm width x 150 depth x height optional. Base, if required to be provided by competitors. Title to be included. To be viewed all round and judged from the front.

Class 2: Wet and Wild – An exhibit to be staged in a light beige niche placed on tabling covered with beige fabric.. Space allowed width 61cms, (splaying to 76cm at front) x 66 cm deep x 91cm high. To be viewed and judged from the front. **No floral foam allowed.**

Class 3: Poles Apart – An exhibit to be staged in a black niche placed on tabling covered with black fabric. Space allowed 61cm wide (splaying to 76cm deep x 91 cm high, To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 4: Weather Today – A hanging exhibit. A suspended exhibit to hang within a space 60cm wide x 60cm deep x drop optional, to hang from a bar height of 210cm. Hook provided. Exhibitor to provide means of hanging. To be viewed and judged all round. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 5: Sunset – Novice Class. Open to competitors who have never won 1st prize at Romsey Show. An exhibit to be staged in a black niche placed on tabling covered with black fabric. Space allowed 61cm wide (splaying to 76cm at front) x 66cm deep x 91cm high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 6: Beachcombing – An exhibit to include: a piece of netting or rope (can be synthetic): a plastic milk carton or plastic bottle and 3 drinking straws (can be plastic) – these items to be provided by exhibitor. To be staged on open tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed 75cm wide x 66cm deep x height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 7: Treasures of the Sea – A petite exhibit. Space allowed 20cm wide x 20cm deep x 30cm high. To be staged on light beige tiered open tabling. To be viewed and judged from the front. Can be brought ready assembled.

Classes 2,3,5,6, & 7 – the tabling will be standing 73cm from the ground.

All Measurements are approximate.
