**Natural Plant Material to Predominate**

**Class 1: Operation Overlord** - Open to any Club, Group or Society and staged by not more than 3 competitors. Staged on grass in the floral marquee. Base, if required, to be supplied by competitor. Space allowed 150 cm. wide: 150 cm deep; height optional. To be viewed all round and judged from the front.

**Class 2: Tea at the Pegasus Bridge Café** - An exhibit to be staged against the side of the marquee on open tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed 75 cm. wide; 66 cm. deep; height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front. A foam free exhibit.

**Class 3: “A Child of our Time”** - An exhibit to be staged in a black niche on tabling covered in black fabric. Space allowed 61 cm. wide at rear splaying to 76 cm. wide at front; 66 cm. deep; 91 cm. high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

**Class 4: Mulberry Harbour** – A seascape to be staged against the side of the marquee on open tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed 75 cm. wide; 66 cm. deep; height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front. A foam free exhibit.

**Class 5: “Music While You Work”** – Novice class. Open to competitors who have never won 1<sup>st</sup> prize at Romsey Show. - An exhibit to be staged in a light beige niche on tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed 61 cm. wide at rear splaying to 76 cm. wide at front, 66 cm. deep, 91 cm. high. To be viewed and judged from the front.

**Class 6: “There’ll be Blue Birds Over the White Cliffs of Dover”.** A Stamobile, (A freestanding exhibit featuring one or more units capable of free movement), to be staged in a light beige niche on tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed 61 cm. wide at rear splaying to 76 cm. at front, 40 cm. deep; 91 cm. high. May be brought ready assembled.

**Class 7: “As Tense as a Coiled Spring”** – a petite exhibit staged within width 25 cms. depth 25 cms. height 37.5 cms. To be staged on light beige tiered open tabling. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Classes 2-6 – top of tabling 73 cm. from the ground.

Class 7 – top of staging 100 cm. from the ground.

1. Classes are open to all and not restricted to members of NAFAS.
  2. All classes will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition 2023.
  3. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.
  4. Only one exhibit may be entered in any class by the same exhibitor.
  5. Aerosol cans must not be used inside the marquee.
  6. FibreFloral or Agra-wool may be used in No Foam Classes.
  7. The Show Council will not be held responsible, at any time, for loss or damage to property belonging to the exhibitor.
  8. Staging will take place between 9.30 am and 8.00 pm on Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. Please bring your own hot drinks.
  9. Only Officials and Judges will be allowed in the Floral Arrangement Marquee until judging is completed.
  10. No exhibit is to be removed before 6.00 p.m. on Show Day.
  11. The Judge's decision is final.
  12. A free admission ticket will be given to any competitor with two or more entries in classes 2-7. Up to three free admission tickets will be given to each entry in Class 1. Admission tickets will be handed to competitors on Staging Day.
  13. Perpetual Challenge Trophies are held for one year and must be returned clean and undamaged to the Secretary, Romsey Show Office, 4 The Old Carhouses, Broadlands, Romsey, SO51 9LG by 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2025.
  14. Entries will only be received on the attached form.
  15. Photographs of exhibits not to be posted on social media prior to judging.
