2025 Advance Ticket Prices

Advance ticket sales will open shortly. We are pleased to announce that we have not increased our ticket prices for 2025.

Membership & Premium Parking are available to purchase now

Benefits of membership include:

- To receive a membership badge which provides admission to the Romsey Show (Saturday 13th September 2025).
- Entry on show day to the Members' Enclosure. This includes access to the members' bar, café, VIP loos and seating around the Main President's Ring and within the marquee.
- Entitlement to Members' forward parking near the main admission gate at the Show.
- The option to purchase guest badges to introduce friends to the members' Enclosure (show admission tickets still required).
- To receive a copy of the Annual Report and Accounts and vote at the Annual General Meeting.



- Be entitled to reduced class entry fees for equine and livestock classes.
- Priority to apply for a Members Premium Parking space (these are strictly limited in number).

Premium Parking

Premium parking is available to Members and sponsors only. Cars must be parked by 11am and cannot leave until 3pm. Please see the benefits of having a premium space below.

Premium Parking price until 31st May 2025: £20 (from 1st June 2025: £40)

Benefits of Premium Parking include:

- Guaranteed reserved parking bay within the premium car parking area on the show ground.
- Arrange to meet and greet friends / families at your vehicle. Non-members can access the car park on foot from the show ground.
- Generous parking bay with room for picnics at rear of vehicle.
- Adjacent to the Members Area.
- If a member of your party enjoys a "retail " experience, you are able to easily access your vehicle to store purchases.
- Worried about the weather? No problem bring as much alternative clothing / footwear as you want.
- There is a dedicated Premium Parking show ground vehicle entrance / exit, which allows for easy exit from Broadlands at the end of the day.

Please note: Vehicles are restricted to cars and 4 x 4s.

All vehicle occupants will be required to have valid show ground entry tickets/badges that must have been purchased in advance of coming to the showground.

Main Ring Exclusive Hospitality

The Spotlight on a Trade Exhibitor – Armchair Dogs



Jessica from Armchair Dogs has been supporting The Romsey Show as a visitor for many years and more recently as an exhibitor. We are delighted to feature Jess' business Armchair Dogs in our newsletter today as we learn more about the brand and showcase the people running businesses attending the Show. You can visit Armchair Dogs on show day in Block K opposite the Countryside Ring.

"Armchair Dogs has been run by Kev since January 1994, I joined as a partner in 2005. We run pet dog training classes in West End, Southampton, and Kev does 1:1 behaviour consults as well. We sell a wide range of treats, some natural and enrichment products such as lickimats. For all our training we use positive reinforcement, so

rewarding the dog when it does what we want. We also encourage owners to let their dogs think for themselves which helps to tire them out mentally rather than physically. We use clickers when training our own dogs and in classes and find it's a really effective way to speed up the process of giving the dog accurate feedback.

Each year we do as many events as we can, but we both also work full time. I'm a headteacher in a SEN (Special Education Needs) school and Kev is a warehouse manager for a flavourings company. We have six events in our calendar this year so far and I've just enquired for another. We have been trading at The Romsey Show for around 9-10 years now, however I've been coming as a visitor ever since I was a child, so over 40 years. It was always a family outing, and we would meet my aunt, uncle and cousins in a layby on the road into Romsey as they came from Bournemouth, and we would travel in convoy. I remember collecting free goodie bags and stickers from exhibitors as child!

Our best selling items at shows are probably our meaty sausages. They are around 30cm long and only cost £1 each, but they smell amazing and on a warm day with a gentle breeze you can see the dogs' noses going up in the air and then they bring their owners to us! If we get the chance to go for a walk about, even we can smell them as we come back, so it must drive the dogs crazy. We also sell a lot of Yak Snacks and antlers at shows. It's lovely now that we've been trading for so long as there are people that come and see us every year. We get lots of customers past and present from classes who come and say hi too and we get to see their amazing dogs as well!

The Romsey Show has always been a part of my life and I was so excited the first year we were successful in our application, we've been there every year since (excluding covid) in the blazing sun of 2023 when it was over 30 degrees, and in the ankle deep mud of 2016 when they were using tractors to tow exhibitors onto the ground and at 8am I had an empty stall!

My favourite bit of the show has always been the heavy horses, I don't often get a chance to see them now as we are always busy on show day, but if I do have time, that's where I'll head."
