#### FLOWERS FOR A GREENER WORLD

#### **Natural Plant Material to Predominate**

Class 1: Earth, Wind and Fire - Open to any Club, Group or Society and staged by not more than 3 competitors. Staged in the marquee on a 122 cm diameter base painted black and raised 10cm from the ground (base provided). Space allowed width 175 cm; depth 175 cm; height optional. To be viewed all round and judged from the front. A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used.

**Class 2**: **Beachcomber - A** Novice exhibit, open to competitors who have not previously won 1<sup>st</sup> prize at Romsey Show. To be staged on open tabling covered with light beige fabric. Space allowed width 75 cm; depth 66 cm; height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front.

**Class 3:** It's a Small World - A petite exhibit. Space allowed width 25 cm; depth 25 cm; height 37.5 cm. To be staged on light beige tiered open tabling. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 4: What a Load of Rubbish – An exhibit to include one or more empty crisp packets, one or more empty cans, one or more empty yoghurt pots, all supplied by the competitor. To be staged in a beige niche on tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed width at rear 61 cm splaying to 76 cm. width at front; depth 66 cm; height 91 cm. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 5: Re-purpose and Re-cycle - A craft exhibit. A decorated box. Staged on open tabling covered in light beige fabric. Space allowed width 30 cm; depth 30 cm; height 30 cm. To be viewed all round and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 6: On the Edge - An exhibit to be staged in a black niche on tabling covered in black fabric. Space allowed width 61 cm. at rear splaying to 76 cm. at front; depth 66cm cm; height 91 cm. To be viewed and judged from the front. A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used.

Class 7: **Wildly Creative** – An environmentally friendly autumn wreath to be hung in a black niche. Competitor to supply a 10cm loop from the top of the wreath. Space allowed width 60 cm; depth optional; height 70 cm. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled. **A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used although competitors are advised that these may drip.** 

Classes 2, 4,5,6 – top of tabling 73 cm. from the ground. (All measurements are Class 3 – top of staging 100 cm. from the ground. approximate)
