2025 Advance Tickets & Membership

The group has been running in Romsey since 1977 and currently meets every week. The layouts take hours to construct including track laying, electrics, and landscapes. The group had a large exhibition earlier in the year in the Crosfield Hall, attracting an engaged crowd. On show day they will be joined in the marquee by the team from the Romsey Signal Box. Merdon Castle Historical Walk Saturday 12th July 2025, 10am for prompt 10.30am start £10 per person

With the kind permission of IBM and Fin and Diana O'Sullivan, owners of Home Farm in Hursley and the 12th Century Merdon Castle ruin, The Romsey Show Society has a small number of tickets still available for an exclusive historical tour. The tour will take place with local historian Dave Key, where he will talk about

Hursley Park House, the gathering of troops during WW1, as we walk to the Castle and then Merdon Castle itself.

The visit will start promptly at 10.30am and we anticipate the visit lasting around three to four hours. The walk will be approximately two miles, with stops along the route for historical information and lunch. There is a limited number of tickets available with pre-booking only, which can be purchased via the Show Office at £10 per person for this exclusive and private visit.
