PRIZES. CLASS 1 - 1st £20, 2nd £15, 3rd £10
CLASSES 2,3,4,5,6 AND 7 1st £8, 2nd £6, 3rd £3.50

Class 1: Touches of Autumn - Open to any Club, Group or Society and staged by not more than 3 competitors. Staged in the marquee on a 122 cm diameter base painted black and raised 10cm from the ground (base provided). Space allowed width 175 cm; depth 175 cm; height optional. To be viewed all round and judged from the front. **A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used.**

Class 2: From The Cutting Garden - A Novice exhibit, open to competitors who have not previously won 1st prize at Romsey Show. The exhibit should incorporate a basket and will be staged on open tabling covered with light beige fabric. Space allowed width 75 cm; depth 66 cm; height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 3: 'Berried' Treasure - A petite exhibit. Space allowed width 25 cm; depth 25 cm; height optional. To be staged on light beige tiered open tabling. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 4: From An Autumn Walk – A craft exhibit – a Collage. To be staged in a black niche and hung on an S hook, competitor to include a loop for hanging. Space allowed width 40 cm; depth 15 cm; height 30 cm. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled.

Class 5: Dahlia Mania – An exhibit to be staged on tabling covered in black fabric. Space allowed width 75cm, depth 66cm, height optional. Viewed and judged from the front, please note the back may also be visible.

Class 6: Home Grown Harvest - An exhibit to be staged in a beige niche on tabling covered in beige fabric. Space allowed width 61 cm. at rear splaying to 76 cm. at front; depth 66cm cm; height 91 cm. To be viewed and judged from the front. **A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used.**

Class 7: Bringing The Garden Indoors – A plants and flowers exhibit.*To be staged on open tabling covered in beige fabric. Space allowed width 60 cm; depth 66cm and height optional. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be brought ready assembled. **A foam free exhibit. FibreFloral or AgraWool may be used.**

*An exhibit which **must** include growing plants and cut flowers.
Classes 2, 4,5,6 – top of tabling 73 cm. from the ground. **(All measurements are approximate)**
Class 3 – top of staging 100 cm. from the ground.

Rules of the Floral Arrangement Competitions

1. Classes are open to all and not restricted to members of NAFAS.
2. All classes will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition 2023.
3. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.
4. Only one exhibit may be entered in any class by the same exhibitor.
5. Aerosol cans must not be used inside the marquee.
6. The Show Council will not be held responsible, at any time, for loss or damage to property belonging to the exhibitor.
7. Staging will take place between 9.30 am and 7.30 pm on Friday 11th September, 2026. Please bring your own hot drinks.
8. Only Officials and Judges will be allowed in the Floral Arrangement Marquee until judging is completed.
9. No exhibit is to be removed before 6.00 p.m. on Show Day.
10. The Judge's decision is final.
11. A free admission ticket will be given to any competitor with two or more entries in classes 2-7. Up to three free admission tickets will be given to each entry in Class 1. Admission tickets will be handed to competitors on Staging Day.
12. Perpetual Challenge Trophies will be presented at Prize Giving at 5.30pm on Show day and after photographs have been taken must be handed back to the organisers.

A perpetual challenge trophy will be awarded to the first prize winner in Class 1.

A perpetual challenge trophy will be awarded for the best exhibit in Classes 2-7.
